Insert various parts in pentagonal and decagonal stars. They look gorgeous like fireworks and flowers.

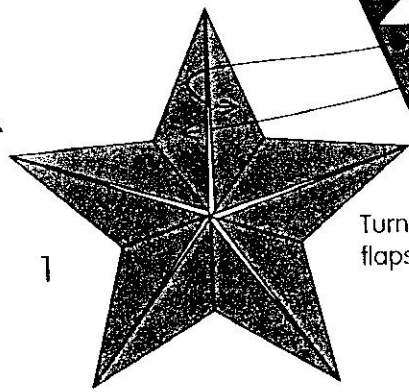
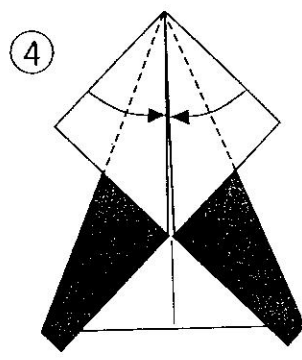


Pentagonal star (back) made from paper of the same size as parts.

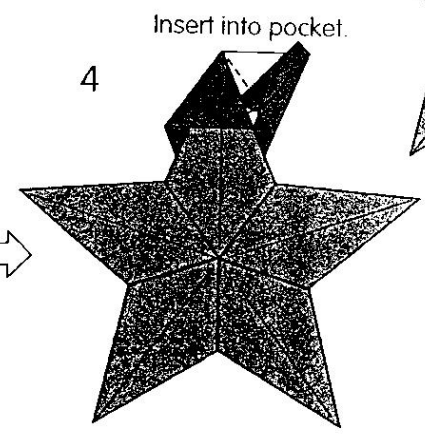
Choose whichever you like as front, 6 or 7.
